

# **SPECIAL FARMINGTON CITY COUNCIL MEETING**

Tuesday, August 28, 2007

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***PRESENT:*** Mayor Scott C. Harbertson, Council Members Rick Dutson, David Hale, Sid Young, and Paula A. Alder; City Planner David Petersen and Ken Klinker, City Storm Water Official.

The purpose of the special meeting was to go on a field trip to the Farmington Ranches Subdivision to view the conservation easement areas located therein. The Farmington Ranches Subdivision is located west of 1525 West and north and south of Clark Lane. David Petersen, City Planner, conducted the field trip.

The meeting began at the Farmington City Hall, 130 North Main Street, at 5:10 p.m. The Governing Body boarded the Mayor's vehicle and traveled to the Farmington Ranches Subdivision. They deboarded the vehicle on the west side of 1525 West near the northeast corner of the project. Staff distributed maps and a table summarizing the landscape proposal from the Farmington Ranches Homeowners Association and the recommendation from City staff for each open space area within the subdivision. Thereafter, they traveled to most of the open space parcels and discussed the proposal from the HOA and recommendations from staff. Additionally, staff showed the Council several instances where private property owners have encroached into common areas or conservation land owned by the HOA with such things as basketball courts, retaining walls, landscaping, etc.

During the course of the field trip, the Mayor received unanimous consent from the Council authorizing City Council candidates to place their campaign signs on City-owned property next to the Post Office site located at approximately 100 East and State Street.

The field trip ended at approximately 6:45 p.m.
