ZONE TEXT CHANGE APPLICATION

(7:20) 4. Farmington City – (Public Hearing) – Applicant is requesting a recommendation for changes to a Scenic Byways Overlay Ordinance proposed to be Chapter 41 of the Zoning Ordinance. The proposed overlay zone addresses design standards for property adjacent to and visible from Legacy Parkway in Farmington (ZT-7-08).

ZONE MAP AMENDMENT APPLICATION

(7:45) 5. Farmington City - (Public Hearing) – Applicant is requesting a recommendation for changes to the Official Zoning Map creating a Scenic Byways Overlay Zone. 
