Mayor Harbertson referred to a letter from David Petersen which explained that the Council recently approved an amendment to the Village at Old Farm P.U.D., Phase 3, to provide for the possible extension of 900 West north of Old Shepard Road. The previously platted three-family dwelling and “20’ Sewer Easement and Public Utility Easement” will be replaced by a two-family dwelling and a dedicated right-of-way.

Rick Dutson made a motion to approve and authorize the Mayor to sign the Revocation and Abandonment of Easement Form for the Village at Old Farm P.U.D., Phase 3, subject to the developer providing the legal description of the easement. **Agenda Item #3 – Approval of Real Estate Purchase and Sale Agreement between E & H Land & Farmington City**

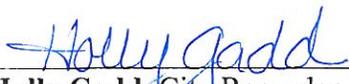
**Motion**
