

PARK LANE (SR-225)

IMPROVED

Sign/signal upgrades scheduled to begin Monday, Oct. 27

PROJECT OVERVIEW

UDOT is installing new overhead signs and traffic signals on Park Lane (SR-225) at the I-15/US-89 interchange. In addition, crews will be restriping the interchange with new lane markings. These new signs, signals, and lane markings are designed to improve the flow of traffic and make it easier for drivers to navigate through the interchange.

Construction is scheduled to begin as early as Monday, Oct. 27, with work continuing through the following several weeks.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Work is scheduled to take place from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Drivers should plan ahead for lane restrictions and minor traffic delays. All lanes will be open from Wednesday, Nov. 26, through Sunday, Nov. 30, for holiday shopping.

Occasionally, construction activities may require a complete closure of Park Lane at the interchange. These closures will be limited to the hours between 1 a.m. and 5 a.m., Monday through Friday. Electronic message boards will highlight changes in the work schedule several days in advance of any change, and updates will also be posted on the UDOT Traffic website and mobile app.

Drivers can use Clark Lane to State Street (SR-227) as an east-west alternate to cross I-15.
