## Fire Hydrant Meter Rules

- 1 - Refundable deposit of \$150.00 required.
- 2 - Non-refundable permit fee of \$25.00.
- 3 - Water use will be billed at the rate of \$18.25 minimum for the first 5,000 gallons and \$2.50 per 1,000 gallons up to 10,000, \$2.80 per 1,000 gallons up to 20,000, \$3.08 per 1,000 gallons for 20,000 gallons and above.
- 4 - Fire hydrant meter will be used in all cases. Any use of water from hydrants without meter attached shall be in violation of City Regulations.
- 5 - Public Works personnel shall designate which fire hydrants are to be used.
- 6 - Responsibility for theft or damage of the fire hydrant and/or hydrant meter shall be that of the person or responsible party whose signature appears on the receipt.
- 7 - Fire Hydrant meters may only be attached to the fire hydrant during normal working hours.  
**NO METER SHALL BE LEFT CONNECTED TO FIRE HYDRANTS OVERNIGHT.**
- 8 - The city reserves the right to revoke permit at any time for misuse or other unforeseen problems ie. Water shortages, fire suppression needs etc.
- 9 - Deposit will be refunded within 30 days of receipt of undamaged meter and inspection of fire hydrant used.
