The Larry H. Miller Tour of Utah is a top international cycling event and one of only four multi-stage, American pro cycling events sanctioned by the Union Cycliste Internationale (the world governing body for the sport of cycling). Some of the world's most prestigious teams and cyclists participate in this international sporting event.



This year's race venue is as follows: Logan/August 3, Tremonton to Ogden/August 5, Antelope Island to Bountiful/August 5, Soldier Hollow/August 6, Salt Lake City/August 7, SLC to Snowbird/August 8 and Park City/August 9. It is a great honor and opportunity for Davis County to host a portion of the race. In 2013, the Tour of Utah attracted more than 275,000 spectators and contributed a new high of \$20 million in direct economic impact for Utah ([www.tourofutah.com/History of Tour of Utah 2004-2015](http://www.tourofutah.com/History%20of%20Tour%20of%20Utah%202004-2015)).

On Wednesday, August 5 the 2015 Tour of Utah race will come through Farmington.

Having the Tour of Utah come through Farmington is an amazing opportunity for Farmington residents to observe a world-class sporting event right here in our hometown. It will also necessitate a degree of planning, particularly for residents who live along the race route. An influx of spectators and media will come to Farmington in the days surrounding the race. **On August 5, there will be rolling road closures and every intersection along the route will be manned by law enforcement and race workers.** No vehicles will be allowed to park on either side of the race route roads and residents living along the route will not be allowed to pull vehicles in or out or onto the street for certain periods of time that day. It is anticipated that cyclists will come through Farmington roughly between 12:00 noon and 3:00 pm. Therefore, careful foresight and planning will be imperative for those residents. A map of the Tour of Utah route is below. Please study it carefully to determine if you will be effected.
