RESOLUTION NO. 2009-60

A RESOLUTION OF THE FARMINGTON CITY COUNCIL AMENDING PORTIONS OF THE CITY'S CONSOLIDATED FEE SCHEDULE RELATING TO BUSINESS LICENSES

WHEREAS, The Farmington City Council has reviewed the City's business licensing fees and has determined that it will promote the fiscal integrity of the City to amend certain of the business licensing fees to better recoup costs incurred by the City in the administration of the City's licensing duties;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF FARMINGTON CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. **Amendment.** The City's Consolidated Fee Schedule is hereby amended to add or amend the following annual fees as determined and set by the Farmington City Council:

7.	Duplicate License Transfer Fee	\$10.00
8.	Regulatory License\Amusement Park	\$100.00
9.	Regulatory License\Solicitors	\$75.00 + \$20.00 per solicitor
10.	Regulatory License\Theaters	\$350.00
11.	Regulatory License/Video Stores	\$100.00
12.	Regulatory License\Fireworks	\$300.00

13.	Beer\Liquor Class A	\$300.00
14.	Beer\Liquor Class B	\$300.00
15.	Beer\Liquor Class D	\$300.00
16.	Special Event License	\$300.00
17.	Sexually Oriented Business	\$800.00
18.	Homeowner Association (HOA)	\$20.00


