

FARMINGTON CITY PUBLIC NOTICE OF CITY COUNCIL VACANCY AND INTENT TO FILL

This is formal notice that the Farmington City Council intends to fill a City Council vacancy caused by the resignation of Brigham Mellor to accept employment with the City of Farmington. Mr. Mellor's resignation is effective July 22, 2018. The City Council intends to appoint a replacement at 7:00 p.m. on August 7, 2018 at City hall during the regularly scheduled Council meeting. This will be an open meeting and members of the public and media are welcome to attend.

Per Utah Code 20A-1-510(1)(b), this notice is posted until July 20, 2018 at City Hall, the City website and the Utah Public Access website inviting all interested and qualified parties to apply for this vacancy.


To qualify for this vacancy, you must file a declaration of candidacy with the City Recorder, during normal office hours at City Hall, 160 South Main. Qualifications to be a candidate are:

- (1) Be a United States citizen at time of filing.
- (2) Be a registered voter of the municipality.
- (3) Be a resident of the municipality or a resident of a recently-annexed area for 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of the election.
- (4) Not be a convicted felon, unless the right to hold elective office has been restored.

*Please submit a one page cover letter expressing your desire to serve and a copy of a current resume to: **Farmington City, Attn: City Recorder, 160 South Main (PO Box 160), Farmington, Utah 84025 between July 1, 2018 and July 20, 2018.** Declaration of Candidacy forms and other related documents must be physically received by the City Recorder no later than 5:00 p.m. on July 20, 2018.*

Please be advised that this appointed City Council position will serve through December 31, 2019. If the appointed member wishes to serve after that point, they will be required to file for the general election in the fall of 2019.
