


**NOTICE OF HEARINGS**  
**FARMINGTON CITY**

Notice is hereby given, that on **Thursday, June 11, 2020**, at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as business permits, at the Farmington City Hall, 160 South Main Street, the Farmington City Planning Commission will hold public hearings to consider requests regarding the following applications:

1. The Project Master Plan (PMP), and accompanying development agreement, for North Farmington Station East, a mixed-use development, encompassing approximately 104 acres next to the west side of -15, north of Burke Lane, east of the general vicinity of 1525 West Street, and north towards the Shepard Lane area (PMP-2-20); and
2. Rezoning approximately 36.5 acres of property next to west side of I-15, a block north of Burke Lane, and east of 1525 West Street from A (Agriculture) to OMU (Office Mixed Use) and OS (Open Space) (Z-2-20);

Farmington City Planning Commission meetings, including this meeting, are open to the public. In consideration of the COVID-19 pandemic, if necessary, members of the public wishing to attend this meeting are encouraged to view the meeting online.
