RE: Water Restrictions

Due to the executive order issued by Governor Cox, declaring a state of emergency due to current drought conditions, Weber Basin Water Conservancy District reducing the District's storage supply of water by 20% and the year's snowpack at 70% of normal with current run-off projections at 30 to 40% of normal, effective immediately the Benchland District Board has been forced to institute the following secondary water restrictions.

- No irrigation/secondary water use on week-ends. This restriction is in affect from Saturday morning at 8:00 am to Monday mornings at 8:00 am.
- No watering from 10:00 am to 6:00 pm weekdays.

These restrictions will run through the rest of the season. We would appreciate your help with these water restrictions to ensure availability of secondary water throughout the summer.
